

Background

During 2018, Kent County Council conducted a Countywide consultation process regarding the future of rural transport in Kent. The 'Big Conversation' was conducted to help us understand how we get better value out of the subsidy that we use to provide bus services and understand if our residents and bus users were open to using different forms of transport.


As part of this process, Kent County Council allocated funding to provide a series of yearlong Pilot routes. In the summer of 2019, we launched 6 new routes in Dover, Maidstone, West Malling, Sevenoaks and Tenterden, We hope that the new routes prove popular and are sustainable and if they are we can look to use them as the basis on which to provide rural transport in the future. In early 2020, the Council was successful in securing Supported Bus Services funding from central government which is being used to continue our Pilot Schemes for at least one more year. Social distancing measures will be observed on the vehicle along with the wearing of masks for anyone without a valid exemption.

What is the Sandwich Connect?

The Sandwich Connect is a new Kent County Council Rural Transport Initiative. Kent makes significant use of taxis and other school transport providers, as part of its network of home to school transport, but there is an opportunity to make greater use of these operators in between the morning and afternoon school runs. Like a normal bus service, the Sandwich Connect will charge individual fares along the line of route as well as accept ENCTS passes. The Sandwich Connect Bus will serve all marked bus stops along the line of route at the request of passengers, as well as offering a 'hail and ride' service in more rural areas. This service launched on 10th June 2019 and is operated by Britannia.

Where will the Sandwich Connect operate?

The Sandwich Connect will operate in Staple, Guilton, Northbourne and Mongeham, providing these rural communities with a link to Sandwich. The bus will operate between the hours of 0939-1603 Monday to Friday only, with the exception of Bank Holidays when there will be no service.
