Useful Telephone SOLAR TOGETHER KENT

Dover District Council is working in partnership with Kent County Council on the third round of Solar Together Kent, as part of Dover District Council's commitment to tackling the climate emergency. Solar Together Kent is a group-buying scheme, which brings Kent households and small businesses together to get high-quality solar panels at a competitive price. Having your own solar panels means you can save on your energy bill as well as reduce your carbon emissions. The scheme helps you through the whole process, keeping you informed at every stage.

Installations will generally not need planning permission. However, in some cases, such as in Conservation Areas and on Listed Buildings, planning permission may be required. For more information, please visit

You can register today, there is no obligation and the more people that register, the better the deal for each household. Approved solar installers will bid for the work in a reverse 'auction'. The most competitive offer from these pre vetted installers wins the auction. You will be emailed a personal recommendation based on your registration details. This includes your costs and the specifications of your installation. The decision is then yours as to whether you want to accept your recommendation. There is no obligation to continue. You will have up to four weeks to decide. If you accept, the winning installer will contact you to survey your roof and set an installation date. All installations are planned to be completed six months after accepting.
