#### **ASIAN HORNET ALERT!**

You might have noticed the unusual activity of placing curious jars in our village hedgerows. They are a monitoring system belonging to members of the National Bee Unit, who are on a mission to track and destroy this highly aggressive invader which attacks our honeybees and other vital pollinating insects.

There are three easy steps to identify an Asian Hornet: Does it look very black? Has it got a wide orange stripe on 4th segment of abdomen? Do its legs look as if they have been dipped in yellow paint?
