SAVE GREAT MONGEHAM FAIRFIELD UPDATE

The deadline for objections to DDC has passed although they will still accept comments on the planning applications for 23 houses on the historic Fairfield. So far there have been over 250 letters of objection from over 200 residents, one neutral and no supporting comments. The petition has gained over 700 signatures. We are now awaiting a date from the DDC Planning Committee when it will be discussed, in the meantime we are still collating wildlife and nature sightings on Facebook.
