CELEBRATING 100 YEARS OF ST.MARTINS HAND-BELLS

Following on from the report in the February newsletter... By 1925 the original set of 8 hand-bells had been augmented by the purchase of 2 further hand-bells in March 1925. This was organised by the vicar Rev W.H. Rammell at a cost of £1.8 3d, using money raised from weekly whist drives. Hand-bell practice was held in the upper room of the Three Horseshoes Pub, which in those days was a games room. This became the favoured practice location for the hand-bell ringers, although the Hand-bells were always kept in the Tower Bell chamber of St. Martins church.

The Hand-bells were regularly used until World War 2 when war commitments took precedence. Part time duties for the disbanded team consisted of Home Guard, Air Raid Wardens and Auxiliary Fire Watching, whilst others were called up for full-time military service. After the War, ended the bells continued to be used for their original purpose, to improve change ringing, and on special occasions. The bell ringing was supervised by Fred and Janet Lawrence. In the 1950s the hand-bells were moved downstairs when the Tower Bells were rehung. By the 1980s the hand-Bells were in need of restoration. Another chapter in the history of St. Martins hand-bells was about to begin. (AP)
